Exciting news!

Following the results of our wrap around care survey, we are excited to announce that Premier Education will offer Wrap Around Care at the school from September 2023.

This will provide our families with the opportunity to use additional school provision from 7:45am-5:30pm.

As the attached letter states, bookings for September will be available for parents of children in years 1-6 initially. Premier Education will be applying for the site to be on a compulsory Ofsted register, which means as soon as they have this for our setting, they will be able to accept childcare vouchers against the Wittersham School provision. This could take between 3-6 months from now to come through.

Premier Education have also stated that, in September, they will gauge the interest to add our new EYFS children to the registration, to allow children from reception age into the wrap around care provision. This is due to them requiring additional adults to meet staff to children ratios for EYFS aged children.


I am excited to see our children engage with our wrap around care and hope this will further support our families in managing childcare in what is a busy time for us all.




